

### **GREENS CLOSURES (Winter)**

Members are encouraged to view the NVLBC website, calendar of events, to see if there is a green closure announcement.

In addition to the website, two signs, stating “**CLOSED**” will be placed on the greens.

Where prolonged periods of snow, ice or freezing conditions exist, a closure notice on the NVLBC website, calendar of events will state, “**CLOSED UNTIL FUTHER NOTICE.**”

**CLOSED** signs will also be placed on the greens as the grounds will be partially or fully covered with snow, ice or freezing conditions.

If there is no NVLBC website notice for the day, but it remains cold, there must be no bowling before **1:00 pm**. This time allows the air temperature to rise and thaw the greens and walkways.

### **Exceptions**

In an event where there is **no closure** announcement or no **closed** signage placed on the greens, care should still be taken as the greens and walkways may be slippery. When this occurs, we ask that you not bowl under these conditions, but await for the temperature to rise and thaw the greens and walkways.
