The Board of Directors would like to invite all of you to an information session at our new greens, 249 East 24th Street, N.V. Although we are not able to bowl at this time, we thought we would like to give you the opportunity to visit our new facility and answer some of your questions.

We will be hosting this event on Saturday, July 24th starting at 1:00 pm.

Attached is a list of questions we think you would like answers to knowing that you will have additional ones as well.

As you know we have established a Footwear Policy for the new greens that will aid in their longevity, so we ask if you plan on accessing the greens to please bring your bowling shoes or be prepared to go barefoot. Along these same lines, no food or drink other than water is allowed in the enclosed greens area. If it is a hot day, please bring your own water. There are two water fountains with filling stations for water bottles.

The new greens have been designed to World Bowls Standards. This being the case, the step from the surrounding sidewalks down to the greens surface is 2" higher than our Lonsdale location. This doesn't sound like much, but it is a noticeable difference. So, we ask that you take care stepping onto the greens until you are familiar with the new design. There are a number of portable steps that are spread around the greens that fit into the ditch to make this transition easier. Because the greens are not quite complete, when we do start bowling we will only bowl in the north south direction.

If you plan on attending, we ask you to bring your signed COVID Waiver Form. This will be much appreciated. The Waiver Form can be found on our NVLBC Website.

During this event there will be a few designated areas for you to make enquiries.

Pat McKenzie and Andrew Fitzgerald as our Games Chairs will be available at our games containers to answer your questions regarding how our aggregates and tournaments will be run as well as how to access the bowling equipment.

John Speers will be available to discuss coaching and the juniors program.

Harry Carruthers, Bonnie Smith and I will be available to answer questions regarding the completion of the greens and the design and construction of our new clubhouse.

It would be appreciated if you would register online on our website (NVLBC.com) so we have an idea of how many plan to attend.
